- Describe your commitment to private prayer. What are your struggles in prayer?

REVIEW

- Have someone read John 15:7
- Why do you think Jesus prayed so often? What impact did this accomplish?
- Explain the connection between abiding in God's word and effective prayer?
- Why does God sometimes not give us what we ask for?
- How does prayer lead to Joy?
- How does prayer glorify God?

APPLICATION

- Why do you think Christians (and churches) often neglect prayer?
- Why do we generally pray for circumstances as opposed to our hearts and souls as Paul did? What does this say about us?
- How have your prayers changed as you have grown as a Christian?
- What have you prayed fervently for but you never received it? Any idea why God did not answer your request?
- How do you respond to God when he does not give you what you ask for? How should you respond?
- What will you do to grow your commitment to God through prayer?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
