- What does Paul mean that he chose them?
- In what way is sanctification necessary for salvation? Perhaps consider Heb 12:14.
- What does Paul mean that we will obtain the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ?
- Why is gratitude a duty? How can it be a duty if gratitude is an emotion?

## APPLICATION

- How is God's love for you different than his love for the humanity in general? What impact should this have on you?
- Why did God choose you? When Did God choose you? How do you know God chose you? Use Scripture to explain your understanding. Perhaps consider Deut 7:7-8 and 1 Thes 1:4-5.
- What concerns do you have about the idea of God electing some for salvation? What security does this provide for us?
- Can you remember the time when God called you? For some God called over many years, but for others he called in a moment. Testify to God's calling of you.
- How does the Spirit sanctify you?
- Are you a thankful person? What brings forth gratitude in you?

## PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
