REVIEW

- Have someone read John 6:1-15.
- Why does John connect Jesus to Moses in vv. 1-4? Hint, read 6:31-33.
- Why did Jesus ask Philip, "Where are we to buy bread, so that these people may eat?"
- What would you think of Andrew's response (v. 9) if he had said nothing more than, "There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish"? What is revealed in Andrew's question, "What are they for so many?"
- Why does Jesus withdraw when he sees the crowd coming to make him king?

APPLICATION

- Discuss the John Calvin quote: "...Christ, of his own accord, takes care of those who neglect themselves in order to follow him. For he does not wait till they are famished, and cry out that they are perishing of hunger, and have nothing to eat, but he provides food for them before they have asked it."
- What looms larger in your life today- the cares of life or the abundant provision of Christ?
- Do you remember the day your first sat at Christ's table and tasted his abundant provision of eternal life? Do you still marvel at his abundant provision for you a sinner?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- Pray for the lost in your life to believe in Christ. Ask God for boldness to proclaim Christ to them.
- Is there any sin you need to confess? Pray for anyone confessing sin.
- Are there any other prayer needs?
