

INTRODUCTION: Col 1:24-25

Paul turns to autobiography to explain his ministry to the Colossians. He begins by explaining that the Christian life is one of productive and joyful suffering.

INSTRUCTIONS

This guide is meant to facilitate discussion which will lead to a response to God's word. Therefore please use it as a tool that best fits the needs of your small group.

OPENING DISCUSSION

• What was the most interesting idea/concept about Sunday's sermon?

REVIEW

- Have someone read Col 1:24-25
- Why does Paul rejoice in his sufferings? How is this strange?
- How are our sufferings connected to Christ's sufferings?
- What does it mean for Paul to fill up in his flesh "what is lacking in Christ's afflictions?" In what way are Christ's afflictions lacking?
- How does Paul suffer "for the church?"

APPLICATION

- Does suffering for the Gospel and Christ actually help the gospel advance? In other words, do you think suffering is not simply a byproduct of living in a fallen world, but is actually part of God's strategy?
- Do you view the church primary as a place to receive or as place to give/sacrifice/suffer?
- In what ways are you suffering/sacrificing for the sake of the church?
- What is one area where you can begin to sacrifice for the sake of the church?
- Do you ever rejoice in your sufferings? Have you ever? Why or why not?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
