- What responsibilities does God give to the church? How does the responsibilities of the church protect and promote unity?
- Why is unity so important in the church?

APPLICATION

- What affect does the body serving one another have on the church?
- Are you consistently serving the people called Hamilton Baptist Church? Are you serving on Sunday (our main family gathering)?
- How do non-believers usually hear you talk about people within your church (e.g. leadership, your brothers and sisters, etc.)? What do you think that communicates to a non-believer if you are consistently speaking ill of your church?
- What does it proclaim to the world when believers care for and serve one another?
- How can this Community Group grow in serving one another?

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
