- What was your biggest take-away from the sermon?

## REVIEW

- Have someone read **Acts 3:1-26**.
- Why do you think the lame beggar is taken to the Beautiful Gate to ask for alms?
- What can we learn from Peter's response to the lame man, "I have no silver or gold, but what I do have I give to you."?
- What do the titles of Jesus in vv. 14-15 teach us about him?
- Do you agree with the statement, "No one can be brought to Jesus unless they are first brought to their sin."? Why or why not?
- What are the benefits of repentance (see vv. 19-21, 26)?

## APPLICATION

- Do you slow down enough to notice people in your life that are hurting and in need of salvation? What keeps you from noticing others who need the gospel?
- Who in your life is hurting and needs the hope of the gospel?
- The lame man is asking alms of God's people. Do non-believers come to you for help? Why or why not?
- What risk might you face living for Christ and calling others to repent? Does the threat of rejection or persecution make you shy away from sharing the gospel?

- Is there any sin you should confess in light of this passage?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
