- Can unregenerate people truly love? What does he mean "everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God" (v7)?
- Discuss this statement: "All God's activity is loving activity."
- What does he mean by the word "ought" when he says in v11 "we also ought to love one another?"
- What are the implications of v12?

APPLICATION

- In what way is your love different from the world's love?
- How can Christian friendship potentially deceive us into thinking we are loving like Chirst, when we are not? What can we do to avoid that deception?
- In what way(s) has God loved you before you loved him?
- In what specific way(s) has the crucifixion of Jesus impacted your love for others? How should it?
- Does the world think of Christians as loving people? Why or why not? Are they right?
- How can we as a church love our local community more effectively?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
