

# Mary Magdalene and the Resurrected Lord

## INTRODUCTION

# OPENING DISCUSSION

- What was the most interesting idea/concept about Sunday's sermon?
- What would you say to someone who said all religions are the same?
- Why is the historical fact of resurrection so important?

#### REVIEW

- Have someone read John 20:1-18
- Describe the evidence of the resurrection found in this passage?
- Why did Mary conclude that the grave was robbed, rather than the resurrection (v2)?
- What about vv5-7 show that this was no grave robbing?
- Read Luke 8:1-3. What do you learn about Mary Magdalene? How does this help understand her behavior on Easter morning?
- Why do you think she did not recognize Jesus at first? Why does she recognize him once he calls her name v16?
- What is the significance of **v17**?

## APPLICATION

- How would you begin to reach out to someone who has only an intellectual belief in Jesus?
- What would you say to someone who said "I'm glad Jesus works for you, but he is not what I am looking for."
- Why does the resurrection of Jesus matter to all people? (Perhaps read Acts 17:30-31 and discuss).
- How has the resurrection of Jesus impacted you personally? How should it impact you moving forward?
- How does the resurrection give hope to the hurting and faith to the doubting? How can you minister to those who are hurting with these truths?
- Why was Mary the first person to see the resurrected Lord? What does that tell us about our Lord?

### PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
