INSTRUCTIONS

OPENING DISCUSSION

- Read Nehemiah 4.7-23
- What do you find interesting/compelling/confusing about this passage?

REVIEW

- Discuss the ways the world opposes God's people.
- Discuss the ways the People of God persevere?

APPLICATION

- How have you faced opposition to following Jesus?
- What are you building? How are you protecting what you are building?
- Practically, what will it look like for you to fight for the glory of Christ in your family, in your church, and in your community?
- In 4:12 other Jews were discouraging those at work on the walls. How do Christians discourage other Christians today? Are there any ways that you yourself might discourage other Christians?
- Do you lose focus when faced with trouble? Discuss.
- How might you direct the eyes of others to the great and awe-inspiring Lord, as Nehemiah did (4:14)?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs
