INSTRUCTIONS

OPENING DISCUSSION

- Read 1 Timothy 6:9-11
- What do you find interesting/compelling/confusing about this passage?
- Do you desire to be rich? Discuss.

REVIEW

- Why is desiring to be rich dangerous?
- Review the fourfold consequences of desiring to be rich.
- What does he mean by "ruin" and "destruction" in v9?
- How does the love of money lead to all kinds of evil?

APPLICATION

- Why does Jesus exhort us to be "on guard" against all forms of greed? What does he mean by be "on guard?"
- How has desiring money impacted you?
- Why does Paul say in Col 3 that "coveting is idolatry?"
- How can you combat the love of money?
- How does one flee from the love of money? What would "fleeing" include?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs
