INSTRUCTIONS

This guide is meant to facilitate discussion which will lead to a response to God's word. Therefore, please use it as a tool that best fits the needs of your small group.

OPENING

- Read Colossians 1:15-20.
- What do you find interesting/compelling/confusing about this passage?

REVIEW

- In what ways does "image of the invisible God" accurately describe Jesus? (v. 15)
- What was Jesus' role in creation? What is his role in creation today? (vv. 16-17)
- Jesus is described twice as the "firstborn." Discuss what is meant by each. (vv. 15, 18)
- List some of the ways that the "fullness of God" dwells in Christ. (v. 19)
- What evidence is there in *creation* that a reconciliation is needed with God? (v. 20)

APPLICATION

- Does your mental image of Jesus focus more on his humanity or his divinity? Why?
- Praise Jesus for some of the wonderful things he has made.
- In what ways does Christ "hold all things together" in your life?
- We say that Christ is the Head of HBC. How does that work in practice?
- When did you know you needed to be reconciled to God? How was peace made?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs
