OPENING DISCUSSION

- Read **Hebrews 3:1-6**
- What do you find interesting/compelling/confusing about this passage?
- Who is this passage addressed to – what does a heavenly calling mean?

REVIEW

- How might we understand Jesus' work as an apostle?
- How is Jesus our High Priest?
- Why is Jesus counted worthy of more glory than Moses?
- How might we understand this terminology of house?
- What does it mean that Jesus is over God's house as a son?
- How are we to boast in our hope?

APPLICATION

- How is the faithfulness of Jesus and Moses a call to faithfulness in our own lives?
- What things do you ascribe glory to, and how does that help you to see how you can ascribe glory to Jesus?
- Consider your appointment and lot in life – how can you point to Christ?
- How can we boast and have confidence in Jesus, and not sin? How does it bring us comfort?
- Do you have difficulty boasting about your faith?
- How does this passage draw you to worship Christ?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
