- Do you find the poem reassuring or troubling?

REVIEW

- Which set or sets of opposites in the poem strike you the deepest and why?
- How does v9 help us understand the meaning of the poem?
- What is the burden/business God has put on humanity (v9)?
- What does it mean that God made everything beautiful in its time?

APPLICATION

- How does this encourage you as you live through different seasons and experiences in your life?
- Why does the sovereignty of God over the times lead us to fear God?
- What does it mean to fear God? How is the fear of God the beginning of joy and peace?
- Do you fear God? How do you know? Discuss
- Were there trying times in your life that you did not understand at the time, but as you look back, you can see God's good purpose in all of it?
- How does knowing that God has a grand plan help you enjoy life now? What are some things you need to
 enjoy more deeply in light of that reality?
- How can the fact that Christ experienced the same frustrations we feel help us deal with difficulties in our lives?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer need
