APPLICATION

- In what way have you experienced the darkness's opposition to the light?
- What are some counterfeit lights?
- How has Jesus brought light into your life?
- Do you have an abundant life? Explain.
- Do you find it difficult to witness about Jesus? Why?
- How can we become more faithful witnesses? How can this group help one another to do so?
- Is there someone to whom God wants you to witness? What are you going to do about it?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Pray for any other needs.
