OPENING DISCUSSION

- Read **Ecclesiastes 6:1-9**
- What do you find interesting/compelling/confusing about this passage?

REVIEW

- Why do you think God withholds enjoyment (see v2)?
- What are the good things in which the man of verse 3 finds no satisfaction?
- Why is the still born better off than the man of verse 3?
- What does he mean in verse 7 when he writes our appetites are never satisfied? What does that tell us about ourselves?

APPLICATION

- What are some dangers that accompany money?
- Is God withholding enjoyment from you?
- Do you think about money too much? If so, what does that tell you about yourself?
- If you were to pursue loving others and inviting them into your life, what would you do?
- What can you do to find contentment in Christ?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer need
