OPENING DISCUSSION

- Read Luke 22:39-46
- What do you find interesting/compelling/confusing about this passage?

REVIEW

- How does the Father answer Jesus' prayer?
- What does Jesus teach us about the nature of submission in his prayer?
- What do we learn about the weight of the cross through the agony of Jesus in the garden?
- Why does Jesus call the disciples to prayer?

APPLICATION

- What surprises you about how Jesus submits to the will of the Father?
- How can you submit to God, when his plan is hard and painful?
- Have you ever been strengthened through prayer (yours or others)? Discuss.
- Why does Jesus teach us to pray by asking our Father to "lead us not into temptation?" Why is that necessary?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- What action/repentance does God want you to take according to the truths of this text?
- Are there any other prayer needs
