- What do we know about this "time of trouble" in verse 1a?
- How does one's name get "written in the book" of verse 1b?
- List similarities and differences between the two destinies described in verse 2.
- Describe ways that Daniel acted wisely and turned many to righteousness. (v. 3)
- What did God intend by "shut up the words and seal the book" in verse 4?

APPLICATION

- When have you been disappointed by something you were hoping in?
- Have you experienced times of trouble? Or know someone currently experiencing trouble?
- Did this message to Daniel encourage you to be faithful or give you hope? If so, how?
- Is your name "written in the book?" What had to happen to make that possible?
- What are you most looking forward to about eternity?
- How does Jesus' life, death, and resurrection give us hope to endure?

PRAYER (divide the group based on gender if desired)

- Is there any sin you should confess in light of this passage?
- Are there any other prayer needs?
